## BONO, BONO EAST AND AHAFO REGIONS: GESOPS

### MEMBERSHIP ENGAGEMENT 2024

GESOPS visited the Bono, Bono East and Ahafo Regions for the second round of the Member Engagement Plan for 2024. The event was from the September 10 to September 23, 2024.

The GESOPS team set out to meet a total of 3,480 participants. Each session comprised of Circuit Supervisors, Head Teachers and Staff, Secondary School Representatives, Non-Teaching Staff and some Ghana Education Service (GES) District Executives.

In the Bono, Bono East and Ahafo Regions, the team engaged members in the 29 districts. A total of 3,385 out of 3,480 members were trained, representing 97% of the target audience.

The training focused on three thematic areas namely; Pensions overview (Tier 1, 2 & 3), GESOPS online portal services and USSD registration (access to statement, viewing of listed beneficiaries and claim submission), and education on the ongoing data collection exercise where members in the various districts were introduced to their district representatives.
